## **Instructions for Greeting Card Frames**

Items you will need for this project:

Fibrous water soluble stabilizer

One 6" X 8" pieces of fabric

5" X 7" Blank Cards and envelopes (available at your local craft/hobby store)

Double sided tape

- 1. Lightly spray the back of the piece of fabric with an adhesive.
- 2. Hoop two pieces of fibrous water-soluble stabilizer.
- 3. Stitch the first color change, which is your outline for the frame.
- 4. Place the fabric over the outline stitches.
- 5. Stitch the second color change, which is the tack down stitch.
- 6. Trim the fabric on the outside and the inside of the frame close to the tack down stitches.
- 7. Embroider the design, following the remaining color changes.
- 8. Remove from the hoop.
- 9. Trim the stabilizer close to the stitches along the satin stitches.
- 10. Use a q-tip or paint brush to run water along the outside edges to remove the fibrous water soluble stabilizer.
- 11. Adhere the frame to the card with double sided tape.
- 12. Add text, photographs, bling, buttons, ribbon etc.
